Monday, January 18, 2010, is Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. Dr. King was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1964 for his work to end racial segregation and racial discrimination. He believed in equality for all people. School will not be in session on Monday in honor of Dr. King.

Walteria is once again participating in Read to Achieve sponsored by the Lakers. This year it was expanded and students in grades 1-5 may participate. **Parents/guardians of fourth grade students: The California Standards Test for Writing (CST and CMA versions) will not be administered this year on a state-wide basis. The elimination of this test will not impact students' achievement of proficiency with respect to English/Language Arts, because both the CST and CMA versions will be scaled and equated on the basis of the multiple-choice questions only.**

TUSD offers school choices for families. **Open enrollment information is being sent home today with your child. Forms are now available in the office.**

Open Enrollment – February 1 to March 13, 2010, This is for students who reside within TUSD attendance boundaries and desire to have a school other than the one in their neighborhood as their home school. This is done on a lottery basis.

Intradistrict Permit – March 22 to May 7, 2010, This is for students who reside within TUSD attendance boundaries and desire to attend another school in the District.

Interdistrict Permit – April 26 and on-going, This is for students who reside outside TUSD attendance boundaries, but wish to attend our District.
